The meeting is smaller than Adelphi; I estimate there were about 40 there, one of whom was Nellie Herman. People come from 30 miles because it's the closest meeting.

Children come in at about 10 min. before end of meeting a most interesting variation on our practice. And it worked just fine.

At the rise of Meeting all introduce themselves and those with announcements make them at this time. One woman announced the coming Spring Workday with a list that would sound most familiar, but included one item I've never heard: work on the grass where it had been attacked by the snowplow.

Then they had potluck, just like ours.

Then they went into another room for Monthly Meeting and 30 of the 40 stayed.
